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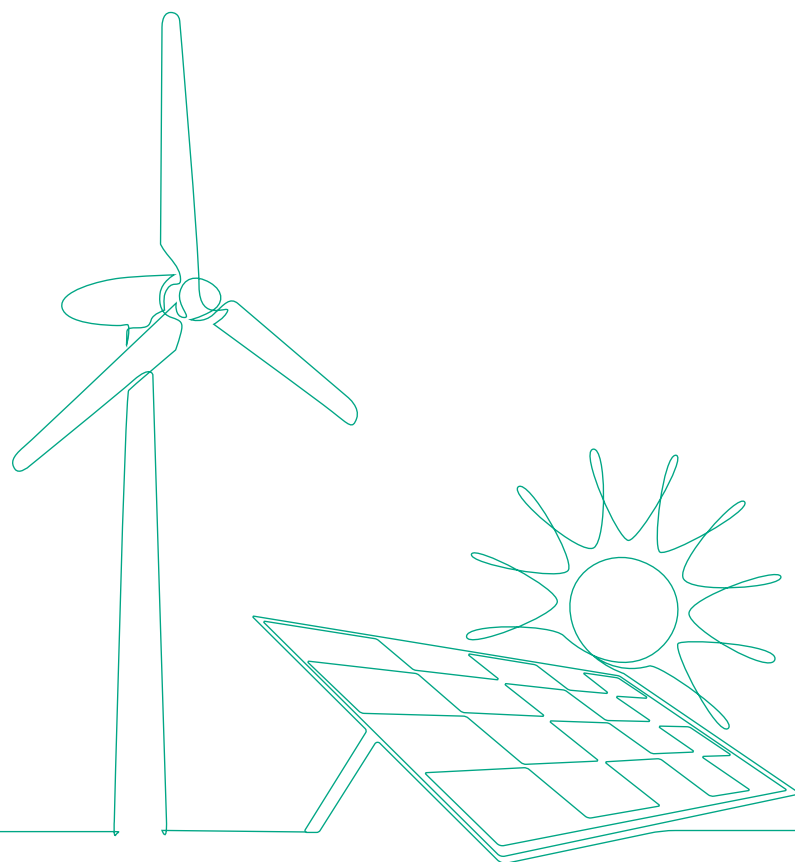
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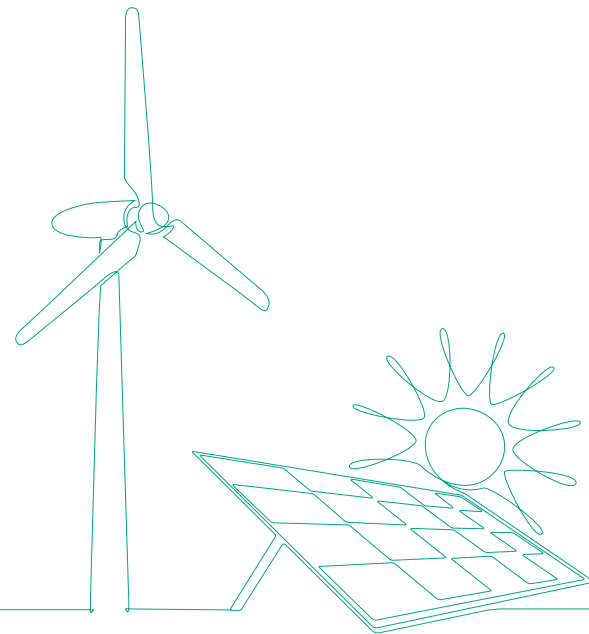
PILOT ACTIONS MOVING TOWARDS COMPLETION

THE FIRST HALF OF 2026 REPRESENTED A KEY IMPLEMENTATION PHASE FOR THE RENEWPORT PROJECT.

Across the partnership, ports and organisations have been actively carrying out their pilot actions, transforming project plans into concrete solutions that support the deployment of renewable energy in port areas.

Several partners have already completed their pilot activities and started evaluating the results achieved, while others are finalising implementation and monitoring performance. These pilot actions are providing valuable evidence on the technical, environmental and operational benefits of renewable energy solutions in ports, while also highlighting challenges and opportunities for wider adoption across the Mediterranean region.





MILESTONE BY PORT OF KOPER

**AN IMPORTANT MILESTONE WAS REACHED BY THE PORT OF KOPER,
WHICH SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED ITS SOLAR ENERGY PILOT ACTION.**

Through the installation of a rooftop photovoltaic system at the Container Terminal administrative building, the port has increased its renewable energy production while reducing emissions and energy costs. The experience gained will contribute to the development of practical solutions and recommendations for other Mediterranean ports pursuing their energy transition.

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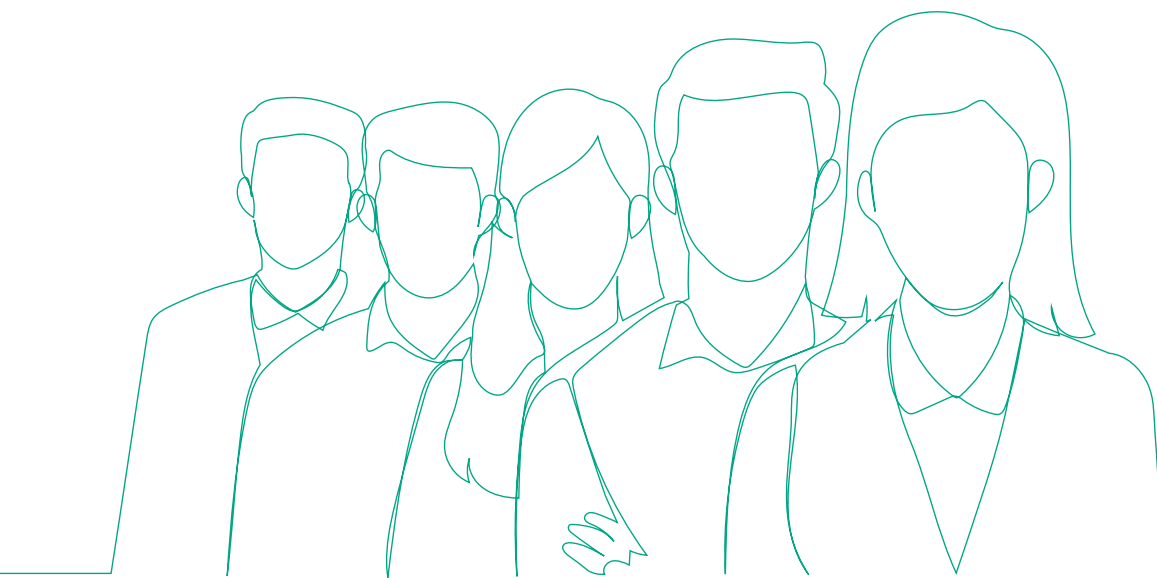
